

Marching to Victory: Complacency Is Dangerous - Josh 13-19

1. There remains land yet to be conquered. [13:1-7]
 - a. Joshua was now old, advanced in years.
 - b. Unconquered peoples listed w/ promise of God to drive them out.
 - c. Joshua ordered to divide land as an inheritance to the 9½ tribes.
 - 1) Judah [14-15]
 - 2) Ephraim [16]
 - 3) Western Manasseh [17]
 - 4) Benjamin [18:11-28]
 - 5) Simeon [19:1-9]
 - 6) Zebulun [19:10-16]
 - 7) Issachar [19:17-23]
 - 8) Asher [19:24-31]
 - 9) Naphtali [19:32-39]
 - 10) Dan [19:40-48]
2. Joshua reviews land given to the 2½ tribes. [13:8-33]
3. Shiloh replaces Gilgal as the site for the Tabernacle. [18:1-10]
 - a. Remaining 7 tribes survey land for their inheritance.
 - b. Tribe of Levi receives only cities, their inheritance is the Lord.
 - c. Lots are cast for determining the land allotments
4. Failure to drive out the Canaanites [13:13; 15:63; 16:10; 17:12; 18:3]

Truths to Be Learned and Applied

1. God is the giver of **our inheritance**. [Eph 1:11, 14, 18; 1 Pet 1:4]
2. God commands His people to **possess** their inheritance. Obad 1:17; Phil 2:12; 4:13; 1 Tim 6:12; Col 3:24; Ps 105:4; 1 Cor 15:58; 16:13
3. Complacency of one's inheritance is dangerous. Jn 8:33; Acts 28:25-28
 - a. This leads to indifference and laziness to **spiritual growth**.
 - b. This leads to acceptance and tolerance of **sin**.
